OUR REVISION COURSES

JDD CONSULTANTS have been running patent and trade mark residential revision courses since 1983. The courses provide intensive tuition specifically geared to examination needs. The courses aim to:

- improve students' knowledge of the law and practice most relevant to the needs of the examination;
- improve students' examination strategies and technique by assessment and counselling on demonstrated performance; and
- provide an environment in which students can improve their knowledge and technique by mutual exchanges of information and experience, informally as well as formally.

The courses are interactive, with break-out sessions to practice and discuss questions. Depending on the course, sizes range typically between 6 and 18 delegates and most of the courses have two tutors to enable close attention to be given to delegates' needs.

The courses for the Foundation papers have a greater 'imparting key information' element, while the courses for the Advanced papers emphasise strategies for tackling each paper. Those attending should have a good knowledge of the law and practice for the course(s) they are attending.

Tutors set pre-course work for many of the courses, including submitting or considering answers to certain past questions. We will provide as much notice as possible of any pre-course work and provide advice on pre-course study and reading.

DEVELOPING OUR COURSES FROM FEEDBACK

We develop our courses on the basis of feedback provided by delegates on evaluation forms completed at the end of each course, and discussions with our tutors. We are pleased that more than three-quarters of delegates rated the content, presentation and practice of exam questions/technique provided on our July and September 2009 courses as 'very good' or 'outstanding'.

In response to demand, we have increased the number of **early bird** courses in July 2010, comprising a Foundation level Basic English Law course and Advanced level P2, P3 and P4 courses and the first part of a P6 course in the popular 'split format'. The latter comprises a one day 'fundamentals of P6 course', held on 17 July. This sets out a recommended approach to tackling P6, with practice of this on a past paper. Delegates then have the opportunity to practice this approach on papers before Part 2 of the course, on 4 September, when the tutors will recap and review with delegates what they have learned and further past papers will be tackled, with tuition and feedback.

In September 2010, we are also holding three further P6 courses with a range of tutors, using our traditional intensive 1.5 day format. There is then, on **1 October**, an additional or stand-alone **one-day refresher/final practice P6 course**, tackling papers not covered on the other courses. This course will be of value to those who have attended earlier courses and seek further practice and for P6 re-sitters.

We hold our first P7 revision courses in September 2010. The first part focuses on UK trade mark law and the second part on overseas trade mark law. There is a third part to reinforce what has been learned. It covers remaining parts of the syllabus and practice of further questions.
